I Learn About the Drill



A fire drill is practice. It helps everyone learn how to leave a building safely.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



The Alarm Begins



The alarm may flash and make a loud sound. A drill does not mean I did something wrong.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Protect My Ears



I can cover my ears or use headphones if the sound feels uncomfortable.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Look to My Teacher



I pause and follow the directions of the trusted adult leading my group.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Line Up



I join the line without stopping for toys or other belongings.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



We Walk Outside



We walk calmly to the planned exit. We do not run or hide.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



We Stay Together



I remain with my group so the adult can make sure everyone is present.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Wait in the Safe Area



We wait away from the building until a trusted adult says it is safe.

Ask Together

What could help your body during this step?



We Get the All-Clear



When the drill is finished, the adult explains what happens next.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?





I followed the safety plan and used my supports. Practice helps me prepare.

What safe choice are you proud of?
