I Learn When to Call



911 is for immediate danger, a serious injury, fire, or another true emergency. It is not for practice or jokes.

Ask Together

What words, pictures, or gestures could you use?



I Notice a Real Emergency



If a trusted adult cannot call and urgent help is needed, I use our emergency plan.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Move to Safety



I move away from traffic, fire, weapons, or anything else dangerous.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Use the Emergency Call



I use a phone's emergency calling feature and stay on the line.

Ask Together

What words, pictures, or gestures could you use?



The Dispatcher Answers



The dispatcher is a trained helper who sends the right emergency team.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Share My Name and Location



I say or show my name, address, landmark, or location information.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Answer Questions



I answer as clearly as I can and say when I do not know.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Follow Safe Directions



I do only what the dispatcher says is safe. I do not touch dangerous things.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Wait for Helpers



I remain in a safe visible place and keep the phone available.

Ask Together

What could help your body during this step?



Great Job - I Got Emergency Help!



Police, firefighters, or medical helpers arrive. I used 911 for a real emergency.

Ask Together

What safe choice are you proud of?
