We Review the Stay-Together Plan



Before going out, we review where to meet and who can safely help.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Stay Close



I walk beside my trusted adult and check that we can see each other.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Cannot See My Grown-Up



Sometimes people or shelves block my view and I may become separated.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Stop Moving



I stop instead of wandering, leaving the building, or hiding.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Pause and Breathe



I take a breath and remember the safety plan.

Ask Together

What could help your body during this step?



I Stay in a Visible Spot



I remain near the last safe place where we were together.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Find a Safe Helper



I ask a uniformed employee, service-desk worker, police officer, or caregiver with children for help.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



I Share Helpful Information



I share my name and my trusted adult's name using speech, a card, or my device.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?



The Helper Stays With Me



The helper stays with me in a public place and helps contact my grown-up.

Ask Together

What is the safe choice in this step?





I used the plan and accepted safe help until we found each other.

Ask Together

What safe choice are you proud of?
