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We Want the Same Toy



Sometimes a friend and I want the same thing. We can take turns.

Ask Together

When might you need to take turns?



A Timer Can Help



A timer can show when one turn ends and another begins.

Ask Together

How can a timer help?



My Friend Goes First



Sometimes someone else has the first turn. Waiting may feel hard.

Ask Together

How does waiting feel?



I Wait Safely



I keep my hands safe and use a waiting card or calm breath.

Ask Together

What helps you wait?



I Choose Something Else



I can play with another activity while I wait.

Ask Together

What could you do while waiting?



Now It Is My Turn



When the timer ends, my friend gives me the toy.

Ask Together

How do you know it is your turn?



I Enjoy My Turn



I play safely and enjoy the time I have.

Ask Together

What makes a turn fun?



Someone Else Is Waiting



I notice that another friend is waiting for a turn.

Ask Together

How might the waiting friend feel?



I Pass the Toy



When my turn ends, I give the toy to the next person.

Ask Together

What kind words can you use?



Great Job - We All Played!



Taking turns helps everyone feel included. It gets easier with practice.

Ask Together

What are you proud of?
